SUBJECT: SCHOLARSHIP OFFERINGS for AY 2007 - 2008

The Scholarship Committee reviews and evaluates the scholarship offerings of SMCL on a regular basis. Below is a list of scholarships for AY 2007-2008. Each scholarship is unique - having its own criteria and specifications. Additional requirements may exist for certain programs and departments as set forth in this Bulletin, in the departmental course listings and/or in department/program descriptions which may be provided to students at the time of admission.

PURA LIMACO ACADEMIC GRANT (PLAG)

Saint Michael's College of Laguna, through its Student Financial Assistance Program offers scholarships and tuition privileges to deserving students who pass the screening. Aptly called **PURA LIMACO ACADEMIC GRANT (PLAG)** aims to open the doors of learning to the youth of the community who are economically challenge of acquiring formal education.

The student can only enjoy one type of scholarship which ever is the highest in terms of tuition discount or privilege.

1. THE PRESIDENT SCHOLARSHIP GRANT

1. Bonafide public or private high school graduates with 85% above average, qualify for the competitive examinations for the following grants:

1st Placer – Free tuition fees for the first four semesters in BSN, BEEEd, BSBA, or AB programs in Saint Michael's College of Laguna.

2nd to 5th Placers – Free tuition fees for the first two semesters in BSN, BEEEd, BSBA, or AB programs in Saint Michael's College of Laguna.

6th to 10th Placers - Free tuition fees for the one semester in BSN, BEEEd, BSBA, or AB programs in Saint Michael's College of Laguna.

2. LIMACO COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP GRANT

Bonafide public or private high school graduates with 85% or above general average and NCAE GPA result of 50% and above qualify for the Limaco College Scholarship Test for the following grants:

Raw Score

90 – 100 - Full or 100% exemption from basic tuition fee for one semester.

80 – 89 - Half or 50% exemption from basic tuition fee for one semester.

76 – 79 - Quarter or 25% exemption from basic tuition fee for one semester.

60 – 75 - Ten or 10 % exemption from basic fee for one school year.

3. ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP GRANT FOR TOP TEN STUDENTS

1. HS Valedictorian	100% free tuition fee	2 semesters
GS First Honors	100% free tuition fee	1 school yr.
2. HS Salutatorian	100% free tuition fee	1 semester
GS Second Honors	50% free tuition fee	1 school yr.
3. HS 3 rd –10 th Honors	50% free tuition fee	1 semester
GS 3 rd –5 th Honors	25% free tuition fee	1 school yr.

Subject to renewal upon satisfactorily complying with the academic requirement of SMCL.

4. DEAN'S HONORS LIST

The Dean's Honors List is published at the end of every semester of each academic year to give recognition to students' outstanding scholastic achievement. To qualify for the Dean's Honors List, a student should:

- carry the full load required including NSTP and zero credit courses unless the taking of a lighter was due to justifiable reasons and duly approved by the Registrar and School Dean;
- not have a grade below 2.0 in any subject including P.E., NSTP and Computer;
- not have a failure in any course including ORDEV, NSTP and any zero credit course;
- not have been involved / investigated of any misdemeanor or meted any disciplinary action

1.00 to 1.40 = 100% Tuition Fee Discount

1.41 to 1.60 = 50% Tuition Fee Discount

The student must maintain the GPA requirement and qualify with the above stated criteria to maintain the Dean's Honor List tuition privilege.

5. ENROLL IN AB PROGRAM

Anyone (new or transferee) who will enroll in AB Program is automatically given the 25% discount on tuition fee subject to renewal every semester upon satisfactorily complying with the following criteria:

- The student must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- The student must have no derogatory record on and off campus;

The student must not have a grade of INC, F, W, UW or AW in any subject

AB Scholars have to render office hours during their free time on their assigned offices.

6. MILAGROS LIMACO SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP (Student Assistantship)

The Milagros Limaco Service Scholarship/ Student Assistantship Program is open to academically capable SMCL College students for them to continue their tertiary education.

To qualify for MLL Service scholarship, students must satisfactorily comply with the following requirements:

- S/He must have at least one (1) semester residence.
- S/He should maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- S/He should not incur any failing grade, INC, AW, or UW in any subject.
- S/He should not commit any misdemeanor or violation of school policy as stipulated in the Student Handbook.

5. S/He does not have financial capacity to pursue his/her chosen course as shown by Parent's Income Tax return or BIR certification.
6. S/He is recommended by the Scholarship Committee based on the interview and Psychological Test Results.

Scheme:

1. For every unit, the MLL Scholar has to render 2 hours of service. He/She will receive a tuition fee discount commensurate to the service that he/she renders to the Institution.
2. The MLL Service Scholarship is renewable every semester subject to compliance with the aforementioned guidelines and availability of funds. (Open to all courses except Nursing)

7. LIMACO SCHOLARSHIP GRANT FOR HIGH SCHOOL

Bonafide public or private elementary graduates with 85% or above general average qualify for the Limaco Scholarship Test for the following grants:

Raw Score

- 90 – 100 - Full or 100% exemption from basic tuition fee for one school year.
- 80 – 89 - Half or 50% exemption from basic tuition fee for one school year.
- 76 – 79 - Quarter or 25% exemption from basic tuition fee for one school year.
- 60 – 75 - Ten or 10 % exemption from basic fee for one school year.

8. LOYALTY DISCOUNT

A 10% loyalty tuition discount is automatically awarded to graduates of all levels who will enroll to the next higher level.

- E.g. Grade 6 to 1st year High School – 10% discount
- HS IV to 1st year College - 10% discount

9. MILAGROS LIGAYA LIMACO LEARNING LABORATORY

Offered to entering 1st year high school students who are economically challenged but intellectually capable (at least 85% general average) to pursue high school.

The student enjoys four years of financial assistance provided he maintains the no failure, no withdrawal, dropped or unofficially dropped status during the four years of stay at SMCL and not been subjected / involved in any disciplinary case/s.

10. BARKADAHANG WALANG IWANAN PROMO

CATEGORY	GRANTS	PERIOD COVERED
1. Barkadahang 3	10% discount on Tuition fee for each member	4 years as long as they stay together
2. Barkadahang 4	15% discount on tuition fee for each member	4 years as long as they stay together
3. Barkadahang 5	20% discount on tuition fee for each member	4 years as long as they stay together

- In instance wherein one or two is / are no longer enrolled / or leave/s the "barkada", the group must complete the number to avail of the same tuition fee discount promo or else they will just be given the promo discount based on the number of "barkada".

11. FAMILY DISCOUNT

Families who have enrolled at least four (4) of their children at SMCL will be qualified to the Family Loyalty Discount:

The youngest child enrolled by the family qualifies for the 100% Loyalty Discount.

In case the number of offspring enrolled in SMCL is 5, the Loyalty Discount given to the family will be as follows:

- *The youngest child enrolled is awarded full scholarship;
- *The fourth child is awarded 20% discount.

12. SIBLING DISCOUNT

Two or three siblings enrolled may avail of the 10% discount that is awarded to the youngest siblings.

The Family and Sibling Discount will be applicable regardless of the academic level / levels in which the siblings are enrolled. Discounts cannot be transferred to the older children of the family.

The Family Discount Program will be applied only to the family whose siblings are enrolled as regular students in any level of SMCL.

13. MICHALEAN AKO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students with distinct performance in their respective fields of interest thereby providing pride and honor to Saint Michael's College of Laguna are awarded this scholarship grant. The Tuition Fee Discount depends upon the type of recognition; honor or accomplishment garnered either on or off school and is subject to renewal yearly for high school or every semester for college grantees.

- Michaelean Theater and Dance Company
- Archangels Pep Squad
- Drum and Lyre
- Medallists Athletes Incentive
- Varsity Scholars

14. SK / COMMUNITY WORKERS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (COLLEGE LEVEL)

The grant is subject to semestral renewal upon satisfactorily complying with the following:

1. Mayor's certification as SK Chairman Officer;
2. Semestral certification of the Mayor's office,
3. No derogatory record on and off campus,
4. No F, INC, AW, or UW remarks every end of the semester.

Recipients are mandatory to share expertise / experience by service via leadership training program, entrepreneurship training and other programs sponsored by the Center for Social Action.

15. INDUSTRY LINKAGES

JOLLIBEE ARAL KABUHAYAN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Open to high school graduates and transferees interested to enroll in HRM. Full tuition fee discount with one free meal and P75.00 daily allowance are given to qualified scholars. SMCL conducts initial screening and Jollibee outlet managers conduct the final screening.

QUALIFICATIONS:

(For freshmen)

1. General High School average of 83 and above.
2. No derogatory record on and off campus.

(For Transferees)

1. No INC, F, AW, UW in any of his / her subjects.
2. No derogatory record.

Requirements:

- Willing to render 6 working hours in any official Jollibee "Aral Kabuhayan" outlet.
- Must carry 15 – 16 semestral load.
- Willing to attend summer classes

SM FOUNDATION

Open to public High School graduates who satisfactorily pass the SM Qualifying exam. SM Foundation shoulders all expenses for one year; renewal is subject to compliance of company policy on grade requirement.
